



We have been a couple for many years, however we hardly exhibit our work together. Our practices are very different, but lately have been growing more towards each other. We both explore the boundaries of painting: by questioning the illusion of the flat surface, by escaping the frame, and adopting sculptural qualities into painting.

A shared fascination can be found in the obscure area between nothingness and something – connected to matter and emptiness, to life and death, or presence and absence.

EVA SPIERENBURG

Educated as a painter, my work gradually shifted more towards multimedia installations. My current practice includes painting, sculpture, drawing, video and performance.

My work describes the correlation between our inner processes, and our physical body interacting with the world. I consider the body to be a carrier for the individual; a shell where our experiences and sensory perceptions manifest themselves and are archived. With my work I aim to find a form for personal matters transcending the individual, in search of our shared humanity. Recurring themes are the vulnerability of the body and mind, temporality, and the encounter between extremities like presence-absence, internal-external, solid-soft, earthly-spiritual.

KEVIN NIEUWENHUIJS

I paint non-existent objects and sculptures in obscure spaces. The subjects are made from fleeting brushstrokes, or are literally removed from the canvas. An illusion of spaciousness is enhanced by the suggestion of shadow, ground and walls surrounding the subjects.

Humans are mostly absent in my work, but the subjects often have human proportions, which allows the viewer to project themselves into the work. The paintings offer space to fill in what is depicted; appealing to the stories that reside within the viewer. My practice stems from the natural obsession with – or rather the fear of – death. Great nothingness. There is nothing before birth and nothing after death. In between, we try to fill the void because nothingness is unimaginable


In the series 'Zonderzijn' (without being) I literally remove the subject from the canvas; all that remains is a hole resting on the horizon. The holes are shaped liked stones; stemming from my fascination with the fact that we recognize a stone by its archetypical shape, yet no single stone is shaped alike. While a stone refers to mass and heaviness, these paintings are ruled by emptiness.

'Hidden remains' refer to the skin, and what lies beneath. The most recent works of this series derive from a drawing journal of physical observations. During short daily meditations, I registered the tensions, pains, recollections and mental states I observed in my own body. Thereby describing the fluid exchange between a perceiving body and its surrounding world.
